

They were, however, clothed with full power over the case, though instructed by the Praetor, and had the power of pardon, because they were held to represent the sovereign people. They were not restricted to the mere finding of the facts, as with us. Undoubtedly this mode of proceeding, both among Greeks and Romans, bears no little resemblance to jury-trial with us, and seems to have had its origin in the small communities, which originally prevailed in those countries. But this mode of trial passed away, even in those countries, and certainly had no direct influence in founding the system among our ancestors, though they seem to...
