

You can learn how to master knots such as the sheet bend, the rolling hitch, the square knot, the clove hitch tied in a bight, the double munter friction hitch, the sheepshank, the Alpine butterfly and the Spanish bowline. Each knot is accompanied by fascinating historical details. Knots have been around since our Neolithic ancestors first tied reef knots and clove hitches thousands of years ago. This book is a practical guide to tying 75 knots, from the simple overhand or thumb knot and the single hitch to the more challenging double constrictor knot and alternate ring hitching.
