It was also found that pitchblende, an ore of uranium, had as powerful an effect as pure uranium, though containing only fifty or sixty per cent of that metal. From this circumstance Madame Curie drew the inference that pitchblende must contain a more active substance than uranium. This substance was isolated after laborious researches, and called radium because of its most characteristic property. Classification.--Radium belongs to a class of radio-active bodies, of which uranium, thorium, polonium, and actinium are also members. The atomic weights of uranium, thorium, and radium are respectively 238, 232, and 225, or 258. The atomic weights of the remaining members of the group have not been determined.
